Directions By Road

From the A40, Ross-on-Wye to Monmouth road, leave the dual carriage way at Crockers Ash, and follow the signs to Biblins Campsite. Note that access is via a single vehicle width track with passing places, which is **unsuitable for coaches or vehicles over 6ft wide**.

Special arrangements can be made for coaches to approach from the Gloucestershire side of the river via 3 miles of forestry track. This is a locked route and only available by prior arrangement with us. Your group will then need to carry their luggage over the suspension footbridge.

Arriving By public transport

The closest railway stations are all at least a 45 minute taxi ride from Biblins. We have arranged shuttle buses from Hereford station and Monmouth bus station as follows:

If you are able to travel during the day and arrive at Hereford Station before 1:30pm

You can catch the 36 bus leaving Hereford at 1:40pm, arriving in Monmouth at 2:40pm and enjoy the 90 minute walk along the river from Monmouth to Biblins.

If you are getting a coach directly to Monmouth arriving before 5pm

You can enjoy the 90 minute walk along the river from Monmouth to Biblins.

If you are able to travel during the day and arrive at Hereford Station before 4:30pm/5:30pm

You can catch the 36 bus leaving Hereford at 4:40pm or 5:40pm and arriving at Monmouth 5:40pm or 6:40pm – both of these buses will be met by a minibus which take you to Biblins.

If you are getting a coach directly to Monmouth arriving before 5:30pm/6:30pm

You can catch our shuttle minibus leaving Monmouth at around 5:45pm or 6:45pm.

If you are not able to leave until later and arrive at Hereford Station before 9:30pm

You can catch our shuttle minibus leaving Hereford at 9:30pm to take you to Biblins.

Leaving By public transport

Shuttle minibuses will leave Biblins at 1:45pm and 3:00pm on Sunday to get to Hereford Station around 2:15pm and 3:45pm.
