The following tables attempt to collate current requirements and recommended practice in delivering safe Woodcraft Folk activities during the COVID-19 pandemic. Please note that this document will be updated to reflect changes in Government guidelines and restrictions.

Please note that the tables below highlight our traditional safeguards and those currently required by COVID-19. The column of recommendations is based on best practice and our risk assessments.

Outdoor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Minimum of 2 screened adults ● Risk assessment ● Consent & health forms ● Register of adults and children ● Adult:child supervision ratio (minimum of 1:3 for Woodchips, 1:5 for Elfins, 1:8 for Pioneers & 1:10 for Venturers) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● PPE in First Aid kit ● Handwashing on arrival, before eating & on departure ● Gatherings no larger than 30 people ● Social distancing of 2m is only required by those 12 years & above, although adults still need to remain socially distanced ● Individuals should only attend if COVID-19 symptom free 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Bubbles/clans based on minimum adult:child supervision ratios ● Bubbles/clans created to reduce household & school community mixing ● Bubbles/clans should remain consistent week to week ● Avoid shared equipment ● Avoid singing and shouting ● Issue kit list to participants ● Isolation area/procedure developed
