

How Clapham District applied to the Coop Local Community Fund

1. We first approached the Manager and Under Manager at our local store to ask for support, explaining that we used to get £100 per group, which we no longer receive.
2. They subsidised our visit to the Pantomime – we reported back on the event. Then we asked for the dry goods for our spring camp, which they provided, and later for our summer camp and again they gave us nearly everything on the list. Both times we sent a report with pictures.
3. We found out about the new Community Fund and asked if we could be nominated by them.
4. They gave us a log in for the application online: see www.coopcauses.co.uk
5. This round is closed but there will be one later in the year.
6. You have to be a member of the Coop to apply and people who are members will nominate their charity for their 1% to go to and if they don't nominate one, then the funds will be shared equally among the local charities. This is a leaflet explaining it.
