Frequently Asked Questions

What can I apply for?

The fund priorities include well-being, improving community environment and skills/training development. From a Woodcraft Folk perspective that means you could include:

- Room hall rent
- Camp fees, including Common Ground
- Volunteer training e.g. first aid, bushcraft, safeguarding
- Residential trips
- Outreach
- Publicity and promotional activity

Folk Office are keen to replicate some of the activity we are currently funded to deliver in the Eastern region e.g. Bushcraft & Social Action days, The world we want to see camp and an introduction to Woodcraft Folk camping. Please contact debs@woodcraft.org.uk if you need any help or ideas.

Can my District apply more than one?

Yes you can. It is OK to use the same District bank accounts and Treasurer contact for multiple applications. Use the local group contact as the primary contact person.

Please do check to make sure each application is in a separate trading zone, so your applications are not competing with each other or against other neighbouring Woodcraft Folk groups. The postcode search facility at the start of the application form should help you identify whether or not you are in the same trading zone.

Can I apply for less than a third share of what is on offer in my postcode area?

Yes, although we would encourage you to apply for a figure closer to the funds available. You could consider hosting a training day for neighbouring groups or an international delegation at Common Ground. Please contact debs@woodcraft.org.uk if you need any help or ideas.
