	Explore people's different likes and dislikes	- Draw round each child on paper, then write/draw on each silhouette 'likes' (inside the outline) and 'dislikes' (outside)
ELFINS	Understand and accept beliefs, customs and practices associated with different faiths and cultures	- Make rangoli patterns or diva lamps at Diwali - Do some simple yoga
	Begin to consider other people's feelings and perspectives	- Use discussion techniques such as <b>Discussion Web</b> or <b>Button Debate</b> to ensure everyone gets a say
PIONEERS	Explore and challenge stereotypes	- Make a collage or poster to compare depictions of male and female stereotypes in magazines and newspapers - Complete the <b>Genderless Story</b> activity (RR)
	Begin to understand inequalities, locally and globally	- Play <b>The Trading Game</b> to explore economic differences between developed and developing countries
VENTURERS	Actively challenge and address inequality and social injustice	- Campaign to increase awareness of gender issues in local schools
	Use people's differing background, experience and opinions to inform the group's activities	- Complete the <b>Personal Maps</b> activity (IfV)
