

## Funding Champion

**Purpose:** To support local groups, Districts and projects to generate enough funds to meet their ambitions in achieving Woodcraft Folk aims and principles.

By participating in a network of experienced fundraisers you will enable Woodcraft Folk to grow, reach out to new communities and become more sustainable.

### Tasks:

1. To share good practice and bright ideas in raising funds between local groups, Districts and projects
2. To proofread draft funding applications from local groups, Districts and projects, offering constructive feedback
3. To promote local, regional and national funding opportunities
4. Highlight local needs to the national Funding Working Group
5. To inform local groups, Districts and projects of Woodcraft Folk's Funding Policy, and the need to seek agreement in advance when seeking funds to employ staff, buy land or sign long-term leases
