



We've started planning London Camp 2018! We need to know which districts are intending to come well in advance, so please check and confirm your attendance (with approximate numbers if possible) by emailing londonwf@yahoo.co.uk. Districts interested so far are: Camden, Clapham, Bromley, Ealing, Highgate & Holloway, Lewisham & Greenwich, New Barnet, Newham Watersmeet, Southwark, Teddington, Tolworth & Kingston, Watford and Waltham Abbey. We will be aiming for roughly 8 villages of 80 people each, subject to attendance.

The central cost will be £50 per person for the week (including activities). It's up to your district to work out additional costs of food, transport etc.

The theme of London Camp 2018 is **The Fashioning of a New World**.

It will be at Belchamps Scout Activity Centre where we have exclusive use of the camping space, and the buildings Vincent Lodge, Kath Batts, Hutch & Den, Coop and Guide Cabin. A site map is included with this leaflet.

Working parties can arrive on Friday night before camp. We need to be off site by midday on the final day so please plan accordingly.

Districts will need to provide their own food and tents. Some districts may have surplus equipment they could lend to smaller groups. Smaller districts will also be paired up to make shared villages.

Activities

We have booked an activity day on the Tuesday. A booking system will be used to allocate these activities. Please be aware that popular activities may have limited places, but we'll do our best to share out the spaces fairly.

There'll also be a camp afternoon on Thursday, where each village offers activities for everybody else. Make sure your district has something they can offer for this!

There is a main central camp fire, a swimming pool, and a wooded area that can be used for bivvies. We will coordinate a rota for these.

DF's will organise an evening café with drinks, activities and a space to chill out during the day.

We will have an opening ceremony, and closing ceremony, featuring a recycled fashion show. Each district should also prepare a short contribution for the opening ceremony.

Other activities may include hikes, a band, an election/political campaign, workshops on topics like refugees and ethical manufacturing, musical workshops, film nights, and a quiz for the adults. We're also hoping to have a programme for Venturers. The MEST-UP and PARTY DF groups will be invited.

We'll be running a competition to design the badge for London Camp, so get your district involved! Send designs to londonwf@yahoo.co.uk in time for the workshop on the camp at the AGM on Sunday 4th February 2018.

Are there any activities or parts of camp you'd like to help run? Do you have an idea for something else you want to run at camp, such as an activity or event?
