Biblins Design a Bunkhouse Competition

As you will know, Woodcraft Folk took over the management of the Biblins Youth Campsite in February 2018, supporting over 5,000 children to camp during last summer.

The volunteer Management Committee have invested much time and energy into the site:

- Cleaning and painting all bathrooms
- Installing Camp Koodoo, a semi-permanent base camp for 40 people
- Updating signage
- Welcoming groups and schools from across the UK

The Biblins site has two buildings for groups to use:

1. The Burrow, designed by a local cub group, sleeps 20 and has everything you need for a short stay
2. The Bunkhouse, built in the 1960s with help from local Primary School children, but sadly today in disrepair

Building on this tradition of youth involvement the Management Committee would like to encourage all Woodcraft Folk groups, and others, to offer their ideas and suggestions for a future bunkhouse to be built in site. Therefore, we ask that you find some time during what remains of the Summer Term to draw/list/record your ideas and suggestions for what you would like the new build to look like. You don't need to have a complete design, a wishlist would be just as helpful. I have included some designs and drawings of the current building for your information.

I am sure you do not need an incentive, but the Management Committee are offering a free nights stay at Camp Koodoo for the design selected as the 'best' by Venturers attending VCamp on site this summer. Please send your designs and suggestions to biblins@woodcraft.org.uk by August 9th 2019.
