Have you already heard about “Youth without borders”?

It's going to be a super cool Erasmus+ Youth Exchange (KA 1.1) with 8 different organisations with each 4 participants and 1-2 teamers, happening in the south of Austria. **The program has been established at our last Youth Exchange together with 30 youngsters from 6 different organisations including the pre- and post-program points.** Together we will develop it further and implement all suggestions towards an amazing and participative Youth Exchange.

For a successful preparation process we will establish an interactive website where all the information will be available for the participants, leaders, project partners and stakeholders.

Within 10 days we'll experience different non-formal education methods, outdoor activities (in the nature as well as in the city), get to know different forms of communication and media strategies, a broad variety of different topics and as well different organisations and cultures.

We aim to present our results at the end of the Youth Exchange in form of a special event chosen by the group in the planning process.

When: The actual date is not fixed yet but it will happen between the beginnings of August till the start of September.

All about the teamers and participants:

We are looking for **4 participants** (gender-balanced) in the age between 14-17 years interested and motivated to be part of a great participative and innovative Youth Exchange.

This group of youngsters should be accompanied by **1-2 teamers** (depending on the funding of Erasmus+). At least one of them should be 21 years.

Both of them should be able to communicate and work in English and being familiar in the field of youth work. With this Youth Exchange the leaders will be strongly involved in the planning and implementation of the program, this needs a basic knowledge about facilitation of workshops.

At the APV we'll invite 1 Teamer + 1 Youngster (under 18) from each organisation to plan the project further and get input from the participating organisations.

The campsite

The Kinderfreunde/Falken-camp is situated in the south of Austria in the federal state Carinthia, next to the Millstätter-lake.

During the summer time we are hosting (international) summer camps from Kinderfreunde and Falcon groups all over the country.

We are creating our small world within our stay at the camp. This is also why it is the perfect place for a Youth Exchange.

Due to the fact that during our stay it will be summer and hopefully really nice weather, we will mainly be placed in tents for around 6 people. If one of the leaders or participants do not feel comfortable staying in tents, we have limited places in small cabins.

There will be 3 meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner. In case your delegation has any special dietary requirements you can let us know with your project application.

There will be WIFI-access during the whole stay next to the seminar room and reception area.

Budget

All costs for accommodation, food, materials are fully covered by the funding of the Erasmus+ program (only during the stay at the project)

According to the new rules within the Erasmus+ Programme, travel costs are reimbursed according to km-distances from the home town to the venue (Döbriach)

Maximum Travel Reimbursement to/from Döbriach:

100 – 499km	180€/ Person
500 – 1999km	275€/ Person
2000-2999km	360€/ Person
3000 – 3999km	530€/ Person
4000 – 7999km	820€/ Person
>8000km	1.100€/ Person

Only this maximum unit will serve as a reimbursement for your whole sum, which you spent on all your tickets, including local travel in your country as well as within Austria.

If you need to apply for a Visa with your group please let us know when you send us the mandate with an approximate amount what it will cost.

In case you don't inform us about it, the visa costs need to be paid by yourself.
