## **The Drawing Challenge**

Design the front of a postcard that captures a moment, feeling, or scene from your time in Woodcraft. Think about the things that make your experience unique. You can draw, paint, sketch, or collage—whatever you think!

- **A Favourite Woodcraft Place:** The spot where you watched the sunrise, the path to the campfire circle, or your favorite tree.
- A Special Activity: Building a shelter, singing around the fire, learning a new skill, or playing a great game.
- **The People:** A portrait of a friend, a group sharing a joke, or the whole camp gathered together.
- **The Feeling:** Is it the sound of rain on your tent? The warmth of the fire? The afterglow on your way home
- <u> Top Tips for Your Design</u>
  - 1. **Be Bold:** Use bright colours and clear lines so your postcard stands out on the washing line!
  - 2. **Keep it Simple:** Sometimes, an image (like a perfect marshmallow) says it all.
  - 3. **Use the whole space:** Fill the postcard to make a strong impact.
  - 4. No right or wrong way: Express it exactly how you see it!
